



SUMMARY OF TECHNICAL COMMITTEE MEETING ON DEWATERING OF THE COPPER MOUNTAIN PIT

September 25, 2024, 9 a.m. to 10:30 a.m.

At this sixth meeting, the available results of the field campaigns conducted during the summer of 2024 were presented to committee members. More than 70 surface water stations were sampled over two campaigns. More than fifty parameters were analyzed by the Bureau Veritas laboratory. A complete sampling of the Copper Mountain pit was also carried out, and the results were presented at the meeting. An update on upcoming work and results was also presented. These will be the subject of the next committee meeting.



Characterization work on fish, benthic fauna, and algal microfilms was completed at the beginning of September, and the committee was briefed on fishing efforts and results obtained in the field. Research work remains to be defined with the group of researchers from the Institut National de Recherche Scientifique (INRS) and will also be on the agenda for the next committee meeting.

Pit water treatment trials are underway, and committee members were briefed on the efforts undertaken by the Osisko Metals team. More results will be presented at the next meeting.
